

**ASSISTANT OR ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR IN BIOSTATISTICS (TENURE TRACK)

Northwestern University's Robert H. Lurie Comprehensive Cancer Center and the Department of Preventive Medicine in the Feinberg School of Medicine seek a highly qualified applicant in Biostatistics at the Assistant or Associate Professor level. The full-time position is tenure eligible. Primary responsibilities include independent methodologic research and biostatistical collaboration/consultation with Cancer Center investigators in the basic and clinical sciences. The Cancer Center offers a broad scope of research that gives rise to complex issues in statistical analysis and statistical methodology. Applicants with an interest in conducting research in related areas of statistical methodology (for example genomic data analysis and/or novel clinical trial design) as well as interest and experience in collaborative research with scientists in the Cancer Center are encouraged to apply. There is an expectation that faculty will teach in the departmental graduate programs.

Applicants must have a Ph.D. in Biostatistics or Statistics, with evidence of scientific productivity related to biostatistical methodology, and experience in collaboration and consultation with cancer-related researchers. Good communication skills and the ability to work as part of multidisciplinary teams are essential. Academic appointments will be in the Department of Preventive Medicine, Northwestern University, Feinberg School of Medicine in Chicago. The Department has a Division of Biostatistics consisting of 14 faculty biostatisticians who provide a collegial biostatistical environment, with a departmental history of mentoring junior faculty biostatisticians. Salary is negotiable. Proposed start date for the position is open. Northwestern University is an Affirmative Action/Equal Opportunity Employer. Hiring is contingent upon eligibility to work in the United States. Women and Minorities are encouraged to apply.
