

**PROGRAM DIRECTOR – MASTER OF PUBLIC HEALTH  
NORTH DAKOTA STATE UNIVERSITY  
FARGO, NORTH DAKOTA**

The Pharmacy Practice Department in the College of Pharmacy, Nursing, and Allied Sciences at North Dakota State University is seeking qualified applicants for the position of Program Director for its newly approved interdisciplinary Master of Public Health degree program. The MPH program will begin in fall 2012 and will be taught in cooperation with the University of North Dakota Medical School.

The Program Director is a 12-month appointment and is responsible for providing leadership, direction, and administrative oversight for all matters related to the MPH program at NDSU, and for collaboration with the University of North Dakota. Responsibilities include but are not limited to the following: coordinating curriculum development, delivery, evaluation, and revision; maintaining compliance with CEPH accreditation standards; coordinating interdisciplinary curricula efforts between departments; advising students; developing a comprehensive plan for program assessment including evaluating curriculum effectiveness; and working with state and local public health departments and other providers to develop capstone experiences and projects.

Candidates for this position must possess an earned doctorate in a related field from an accredited institution; a distinguished record of teaching, research, and service commensurate with the rank of Associate Professor or Professor with tenure; strong leadership skills; established interpersonal, communication, and administrative skills; demonstrated ability to work cooperatively with others; active licensure in one's major field (if applicable); a strong interest in interdisciplinary education; and teaching or administrative experience in a CEPH accredited public health program.

Preferred qualifications include a master or doctorate degree in public health, experience with online course delivery, established grant writing skills, experience with rural health issues, and a strong background in one of the disciplines involved in teaching the NDSU program.
