

## Faculty Positions

One or two faculty positions are available in the Division of Biostatistics at the Indiana University School of Medicine. Position level (Assistant, Associate or Full) is dependent upon the qualifications of the applicant. Responsibilities include collaborative research, methodological statistical research and teaching. Requirements include a Ph.D. in biostatistics or statistics, practical collaborative experience and excellent communication skills. The positions offer competitive salaries and excellent benefits.

This is an exciting opportunity to join an established Biostatistics group dedicated to excellence in statistical and collaborative research in the health sciences. The Division is located in the Department of Medicine but performs collaborative research with all departments in the School of Medicine as well as the Schools of Dentistry, Nursing and Law.
