The Harvard School of Public Health-Cyprus International Initiative for the Environment and Public Health (the Initiative) is pleased to announce an annual tuition scholarship award in environmental health studies for qualified students from Southeastern and East-Central Europe.

These scholarships support outstanding students from the region accepted in the Postgraduate Program in Environmental Health at the Cyprus International Institute for the Environment and Public Health located in Nicosia, Cyprus. This unique masters-level program takes place over a 12-month period (September through August) encompassing over 50 course credits. Its primary mission is to recruit outstanding students from the region in environmental health and to provide them with the skills necessary to assume leadership positions in research, government and the private sector.

The Program accepts applications from outstanding students from Southeastern and East-Central Europe;

Candidates from various disciplines are encouraged to apply, including medicine, engineering, public health, as well as physical and biological sciences;

The Program trains students to assume key academic and research positions in environmental health throughout the region;

Full tuition scholarships are offered to highly-qualified candidates.
