H1N1 VIRUS (SWINE FLU) SURVEY II

May 5-6, 2009

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HARVARD SCHOOL OF PUBLIC HEALTH
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The study was conducted for Harvard School of Public Health via telephone by SSRS/ICR, an independent research company. Interviews were conducted May 5-6, 2009, among a representative sample of 1,013 respondents age 18 and older. Of those a total of 130 respondents were Hispanic and a total of 112 respondents were Non-Hispanic African Americans. A total of 150 interviews were conducted with respondents on cell phones. The margin of error for total respondents is +/-3.6 percentage points at the 95% confidence level.
