What are Admissions Contingencies?

Every admitted student will have their own unique admissions contingencies that they must complete to enroll. Unresolved contingencies will lead to holds and delay enrollment.

You can view your admissions contingencies on the "Harvard Chan" tab of your my.harvard portal. Below is an example of some possible items you may see in your portal. This is only an example:



Contingency Status:

Completed Contingencies: Contingencies with a green checkmark are complete. No further action is required.



Outstanding Contingencies: Contingencies with a red exclamation point are outstanding. Click the specific item's hyperlinked title for more details on what must be done to fulfill the contingency. The due date for completing the contingency is displayed beneath the contingency.
