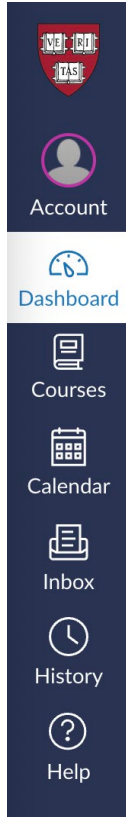




Canvas Guide | Student Account Settings

Canvas is the learning management system at the Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health. It is where to access your daily coursework and assignments.



What should I do first in Canvas?

Login

- Login at canvas.harvard.edu. Need login help? Visit key.harvard.edu.

Account

- **Settings. Verify your school email address.** (Click Account → Settings → look in top right for ‘Ways to Contact’).
- **Settings. Optional - Select your Personal Pronouns** (Click Account → Settings → on right, click Edit Settings → [select a personal pronouns](#) from drop down list on left)
- **Profile.** Fill in your canvas profile. (Account → Profile to edit your global Canvas profile).
- **Notifications. Set Course Announcements** to ‘Immediately’. (Account → Notifications → find Announcements row → click icon on right and change to immediately)

Dashboard

- **No action needed.** Once you’re enrolled in my.Harvard AND the instructor has published the site, it will appear here automatically. (Click once on a course card to enter the site.)
- **Full list of my enrolled courses** (Click Courses → All Courses) Note: If it says ‘No’ in far right published column, this means that the instructor has not yet published the site.

Optional Settings

- **Calendar.** Some faculty may not choose to use this tool, so it is better to consult the instructor’s syllabus instead. (Import to [office 365](#), [google calendar](#), or [apple calendar](#))
- **Record your Name Pronunciation** (Login to my.Harvard to record an audio of your name) If the Name Pronunciation tab is enabled by the instructor, you will find it on the left sidebar in a course.
