



**CONSENT TO RELEASE STUDENT INFORMATION**

In accordance with the Federal Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA) (20.U.S.C. 1232g), the Office of Financial Aid is prohibited from releasing information regarding a student's financial aid status without written consent of the student. Exceptions to this rule include authorized federal, state, and local educational authorities as set forth in the law.
