What is MFA?

MFA is a process to identify a person multiple ways. It insures a stolen password itself doesn't lead to a stolen email, banking, or social media account.

The 3 Factors of MFA

Something you
KNOW

Password or phrase
PIN

Something you
HAVE



Code from app or SMS
Push notification
USB token

Something you
ARE



Finger or thumb print
Face scan
Iris scan
