Unique



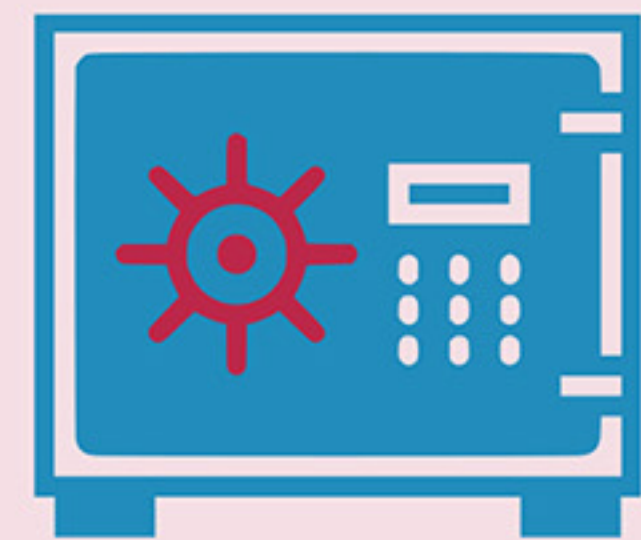
Create a strong and unique password for each of your accounts. Reusing passwords makes one stolen password a much bigger problem.

Private

Stored Securely
