Description: Each summer, AMOS provides a three-week, 120-hour Global Health Practicum course that aims to empower a socially-conscious generation of public health workers. Fostering critical analysis of international health development and social theories of power and privilege, the practicum studies current models and methodologies for improving health in low-resource settings. Students can extend their practicum experience for five weeks, working with other interns and staff in AMOS' community health programs. Apply skills gained in the practicum to our on-going health initiatives: Community Nutrition, Clean Water, Healthy Schools, Patient Care, PhotoVoice, Youth Empowerment, and Volunteer Mothers.
