Harvard University Health Services Immunization Requirements:

The Massachusetts Immunization Law is a requirement for all **degree, non-degree and international** Harvard University students.

We recommend that you receive your immunizations before you arrive at Harvard, since many health insurance plans cover the costs of immunizations. Students unable to receive immunizations before arriving on campus must arrange for immunizations in the local area. If you receive your immunizations at Harvard University Health Services (HUHS), you may be billed for the cost of the immunization.

At Harvard T. H. Chan School of Public Health, you will need to clear your immunization before you enroll in courses. In order to register for courses, students must submit their completed Harvard University Health Services (HUHS) immunization forms as listed on HUHS's website. Students are encouraged to review the requirements promptly to allow time to obtain and submit documentation. When possible, we encourage students to receive all required vaccinations before arrival at Harvard. Many health insurance plans may also cover the costs of vaccinations. Please allow at least two weeks of processing time for documents to be reviewed. Please direct all immunization questions and paperwork to Harvard University Health Services (HUHS).
