 - This may require coming up with some information on scenarios in which this relationship would matter (e.g., what size and socio-economic characteristics of diaspora populations do you assume when you say that they can contribute to a certain SDG target? What are the specific vulnerabilities, needs and capabilities of the refugee, IDP, or immigrant population that makes you highlight a certain SDG target?)
- The Government of Globalia has asked you to provide suggestions on how to integrate migration and displacement into its policy agenda. Based on the scenario(s) and relationship you described in the previous point, write down ideas for policy and programming interventions that could be devised to affect this relationship. Highlight what information would be needed to devise and implement such programs, what challenges you foresee in this regard and what is the 'theory of change,' that is, the logical steps that lead from specific policy and programming activities to the desired outcome.
