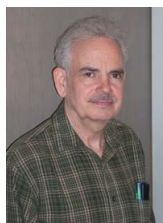


HSPH Freedom Rider

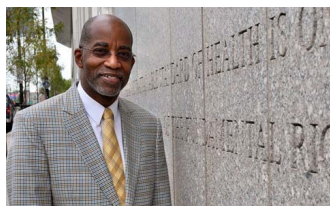
