





Access for Vulnerable Moms

Access Issues	Bangladesh	South Africa	India
Mode of Access	Majority pay for IVR calls, one third pay for SMS, and 4% receive free calls	IVR cost prohibitive, limited free SMS supply, most reached via free mobile web	Free IVR calls only, overcame device barriers to calls being received
Reaching Vulnerable Moms	Cost-related challenges reaching bottom of the pyramid	Challenge to reach HIV+ women early enough for effective PMTCT	Enrollment strategies geared for bottom of the pyramid
Literacy & Ownership	Increase found	Findings soon	Current study exploring
